### **REMINDER: Parish Livestreaming/Recording Update**

Dear friends, I write to inform you that we shall be discontinuing our parish's livestreaming of Sunday Mass (the Saturday anticipated Mass at 4pm). We will also no longer be recording and uploading those videos for later viewing to our YouTube channel. Our parish began livestreaming and recording Masses at the beginning of the pandemic, and responded accordingly to how the restrictions changed, including streaming all our daily Masses while in total lockdown. For a variety of reasons, changes were made to our livestreaming/recording either due to the changes in the pandemic or our ability to continue having the right people in place to give of their time and ability.

At the beginning of this New Year, we continue to reflect on these factors and how they impact our livestreaming/recording of Mass. Currently, livestreaming/recording has become quite a challenge to our ministers involved, which is further complicated by all of the legal considerations that comes with broadcasting copywritten music over the internet. We strove to ensure our livestreaming/recording was all done properly, legally, and morally by purchasing a license which was renewed annually. At this point, however, we see the increased difficulty with continuing as we are, as well as there being less of a need for our parishioners to pray with the Mass virtually, so we discerned to discontinue this practice.

This weekend will be the last recorded Mass.

We certainly do this with the care for those who are homebound in mind, and so we remind all that pastoral visits to the homebound with the Eucharist are possible by contacting us, as well as the great variety of channels and means that the Mass is still being broadcasted to those who are homebound and are of superb quality.

## Word of God Sunday

---

In his Apostolic Letter *Aperuit illis* issued September 30, 2019, Pope Francis instituted the celebration of Sunday of the Word of God, which is held every year on the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time. The title of the letter is taken from Luke 24:45, where the Evangelist describes how the Risen Jesus appeared to two disciples on the road to Emmaus, and “He opened their minds to understand the Scriptures”. This weekend then, our parish will be celebrating Word of God Sunday. Of course, the Scriptures have an essential place within the Eucharistic liturgy, and indeed, in every Christian liturgy and sacrament.

Last weekend at the end of all three Masses, we had a special blessing and commissioning of the members of our parish who serve their brothers and sisters as Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. This weekend, we shall celebrate Word of God Sunday by a similar blessing and commissioning of those who serve as Lectors, ministers who seek to proclaim the Story of Salvation in the midst of the congregation and in their daily lives.

There are two other particular ways that I would really like to encourage us to consider in gratitude for God’s Love Letter to us in the Scriptures. The first would be to consider checking out the *Bible in a Year* podcast if you have not yet already. Or if you’re like me and started a while ago but fell away due to the business of life, get back in. It’s an excellent program that’s really opened up the Scriptures in a helpful way to many, many people throughout the world since it started in 2021. Fr. Mike Schmitz who was the voice of that program also just began a similar one with *Catechism in a Year* this year if that strikes your interest.

The second way I would encourage us to grow in appreciation of the Word of God would be to learn more about our local, diocesan initiative called “Households of Faith”. A “Household of Faith” is a small group of 6 to 10 people from a variety of backgrounds and life journeys who come together on a regular basis, at least once a month, in-person or online, for 60 to 90 minutes. The purpose of this time together is to get to know one another and grow in new friendships, while sharing the Holy Scriptures and some reflection using a simple process. I would encourage you to check out what is on the Archdiocese’s website to learn more and pray about it. Our parish will be having a little kick-off event on the last Sunday before Lent, February 19th, as a sort of experience of what it could be like, the opportunity to learn more about it, and to meet others who may also be interested in being part of a “Household of Faith”. Certainly, if you wanted to start up your own “Household of Faith” before then, you can do so as you wish!

All parishioners are invited to attend our annual CGT for 2022





Fr. Brian will be attending World Youth Day in Portugal in August and so he will be working (not singing:)) at the Coffee House that evening!


## Christian Supply Centre Closing Sale


## Saint Francis de Sales: Pastor of Souls
